Please remember children should be wearing black shoes for school and not trainers. We understand there are only a few more weeks and are grateful for your co-operation.


Some of the **Year 6** children are going to Winmarleigh Hall on a residential trip this week. We hope you have a good time and can't wait to hear all about it.
